

**FIRST TIMERS-** Colorado is making its first-ever appearance at Acrisure Arena, after the Eagles claimed back-to-back overtime wins over the Firebirds at the BEC in November. Coachella Valley is in its inaugural season of play as the AHL's 32<sup>nd</sup> franchise and affiliates of the Seattle Kraken. The Firebirds have been led this season by forward Kole Lind who has collected 31 points through 29 games this season, while fellow forward Jesper Froden produced 15 goals and 15 assists. Alex Galchenyuk and Mitchell Vande Sompel have each generated two points in the first two games of the season series against the Firebirds, as goaltender Justus Annunen is 1-0 against Coachella Valley with a 0.94 GAA and a .973 save-percentage.

**UPWARD TRAJECTORY**- Forward Cal Burke comes into tonight's game having notched points in three straight games and has posted three goals and four assists over his last six contests. Now sitting on nine goals and nine assists through 28 games, Burke is well on pace to surpass the 12 goals and 14 assists he collected last season. This year has also seen the third-year pro out of the University of Notre Dame make his NHL debut, skating in two games with the Colorado Avalanche in December.

**BACK IN THE SADDLE**- Forward Charles Hudon makes his return to the Eagles lineup tonight after skating in a pair of games with the Colorado Avalanche. Hudon leads the Eagles this season with 10 goals in 22 games, while his 18 points are tied for second on the team. Now in his ninth professional season, the 28-year-old netted a pair of goals in his last AHL game with Colorado, a 4-3 win over the Bakersfield Condors on December 21<sup>st</sup>. In addition, his nine points via specialty teams are tied with Brad Hunt for the most on the Eagles roster.

**HEAD-TO-HEAD** – Tonight's matchup features an Eagles team that has been one of the stingiest in the AHL this season, allowing an average of just 2.50 goals-against per contest, which ranks third in the league. On the flipside, the Firebirds are third in the AHL in goals-for, putting up an average of 3.79 goals per game. Colorado has relied on winning a bevy of tight games this season, as 17 of the team's 30 games have been decided by just one goal, with the Eagles posting a record of 11-4-2 in those contests.

**MOVING ALONG-** Forward Jean-Luc remains red-hot after the first two games of the Eagles current five-game road trip. Foudy is riding a three-game point streak and has now generated five goals and 13 assists in just 22 AHL games with Colorado this year. The 20-year-old is building off a 2021-22 campaign that saw him notch nine goals and 17 assists. Foudy returned to the Eagles two weeks ago after skating in nine NHL games with the Colorado Avalanche.

Branham was drafted in the third round of the 2000 NHL Entry Draft by the Vancouver Canucks and played 284 professional games in the ECHL and AHL during his playing career as a defenseman from 2002-2010.

#### **Career Notes:**

Cronin, 59, has spent over 30 seasons in coaching, including 12 years as an assistant in the NHL and seven seasons as a head coach at the AHL level. He spent four years on the New York Islanders' coaching staff, serving three seasons as an assistant before being promoted to Associate Coach in 2017-18. It marked his second stint with the Islanders, as he previously was an assistant coach with the team from 1998 to 2003. Prior to his recent time in New York, Cronin was an assistant with the Toronto Maple Leafs for three seasons from 2011-14, helping the Leafs to their first playoff appearance in nine years in 2013.

Cronin served two seasons as head coach of the Islanders' AHL team, the Bridgeport Sound Tigers, from 2003-05. The Arlington, Mass., native led the Sound Tigers to the playoffs during his first season in 2003-04 with a record of 41-23-16 (98 points).

Following his time with Bridgeport, Cronin spent six seasons as the head coach at Northeastern University from 2005-06 to 2010-11. He helped rebuild the Huskies program, improving from three wins in his first season to an NCAA tournament appearance in 2009, the school's first in 15 years. That season, he won Hockey East's Bob Kullen Coach of the Year Award.

Cronin was an assistant coach at the University of Maine (1988-90, 1993-95) and Colorado College (1990-93), and also spent time as interim head coach at both institutions, as well (Colorado College in 1992 and Maine in 1995-96). Following a four-year playing career at Colby College (1982-86), Cronin began his coaching career at his alma mater in 1987-88.

One of the co-founders of the United States National Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich., Cronin served as the head coach and director of player development for the U.S. Under-18 Team for two years from 1996-98. Internationally, Cronin worked as an assistant coach for Team USA at the 1997, 2011 and 2012 IIHF World Championship, as well as the 1997 and 1998 IIHF World Junior Championship, where he helped the U.S. Junior National Team to a silver medal in 1997.
