The Knights' Tale - The Silver Knights complete a home-and-home set with the Coachella Valley Firebirds on Saturday night at Acrisure Arena. The HSK took the opener on Friday with a 7-4 victory at The Dollar Loan Center. Sakari Manninen netted the first hat trick of the season for Henderson and Gage Quinney posted a four-point game. Brendan Brisson also added two goals, while Cameron Hughes netted a hat trick for the Firebirds. The victory was the Silver Knights first ever against the Firebirds, who had won the previous five meetings.

Offensive Outburst - The Silver Knights scored seven goals in a game for the second time this season, matching a franchise record, and started things off with a goal 16 seconds into the game to mark their fastest goal to start a game in franchise history. After their five goal third period vs Bakersfield last Saturday, the Silver Knights have scored 12 goals in their last four periods of game action.

Ragin' Gage - After posting one four-point game over the first 283 games of his AHL career, Quinney has totaled four points in each of his last two games. Quinney had four assists Saturday vs Bakersfield and followed up with two goals, two assists, and a plus-5 rating Friday vs Coachella Valley. Quinney has posted career-highs in goals, assists, points, and power play goals this season. On Saturday, he collected the 200th point of his AHL career.

He's the Mann - Sakari Manninen has five goals in the last two games after recording his first AHL hat trick, and the sixth hat trick in Silver Knights history. With nine goals on the season, more than half of Manninen's goal-scoring production this season has come in the last four periods.

Can't Miss Briss - Brendan Brisson posted his first multi-goal game in the AHL Friday. He totaled six goals and 11 points in his last 11 games.

Cooling Firebirds - The Firebirds have lost three straight in regulation for the first time this season. They surrendered 16 goals during their three-game road trip.
