

BACK AGAIN- Colorado is making just its second appearance at Acrisure Arena, after the Eagles fell 4-2 to the Firebirds back on January 4th. Colorado claimed back-to-back overtime wins over Coachella Valley at the BEC in November. The Firebirds have been led in the season series by forward Andrew Poturalski who has four points in three games against the Eagles. Forward Alex Galchenyuk has paced Colorado with a goal and two assists in those same three contests, while fellow forward Mikhail Maltsev has netted two goals in two games against Coachella Valley. Goaltender Justus Annunen is 1-1 against the Firebirds with a 1.95 GAA and a .943 save-percentage.

MOVING UP- After clinching a spot in the 2023 Calder Cup Playoffs on Sunday, the Eagles notched a 4-2 win over Ontario on Wednesday and are currently tied with Abbotsford for third place in the division, with one game in hand on the Canucks. Wednesday's win also added some cushion between Colorado and Ontario, with the Reign still trailing the Eagles in fifth place. A top-four finish would ensure home-ice advantage for at least the first round of the postseason. The Eagles have just seven games left in the regular season, with five of those contests coming on the road.

WELCOME ABOARD- Colorado recently added three new faces to the roster, as the team signed forward Jason Polin and defenseman Sam Malinski to a PTO on Thursday and inked forward Matthew Stienburg to an ATO on Friday. Polin led all NCAA skaters with 30 goals for Western Michigan this season, setting an NCHC record. He ranked second on the team in points, tied for first in power-play goals (6) and recorded five hat tricks. He was also named the NCHC's Player of the Year and is a top-10 finalist for the Hobey Baker Award. Malinski just finished his senior year at Cornell University, where he recorded 26 points (8g/18a) in 34 outings. Named team captain as a senior, the blueliner ranked third on the team and first among defenseman in points and ranked second on the team in assists. Stienburg was teammates with Malinski at Cornell and generated 13 goals and 16 assists in 29 games during his junior season.

CAREER PACE- Forward Charles Hudon comes into tonight's game leading the team in goals (26), assists (23) and points (49), having netted five goals and two assists in his last five contests. In addition, Hudon's 17 power-play goals currently lead all skaters in the AHL. The 28-year-old is closing in on the career-high 30 goals and 27 helpers he notched last season with the Syracuse Crunch. The two-time AHL All-Star has netted at least 27 goals in four of his first five seasons in the league.





Following a four-year playing career at Colby College (1982-86), Cronin began his coaching career at his alma mater in 1987-88.

One of the co-founders of the United States National Development Program in Ann Arbor, Mich., Cronin served as the head coach and director of player development for the U.S. Under-18 Team for two years from 1996-98. Internationally, Cronin worked as an assistant coach for Team USA at the 1997, 2011 and 2012 IIHF World Championship, as well as the 1997 and 1998 IIHF World Junior Championship, where he helped the U.S. Junior National Team to a silver medal in 1997.
