COACHING STAFF

COLIN CHAULK - HEAD COACH

Colin Chaulk was named head coach on June 27, 2022. Chaulk, who became interim head coach on February 11, 2022, is the third head coach in the team's American Hockey League history and ninth overall in the organization's 25 seasons. In his first full season behind the bench, Chaulk guided the team to a 37-31-4 (.524) season and a second straight Calder Cup Playoffs berth. The record included a team record 10 straight home wins to finish the season. Chaulk went 19-12-3 (.603%) at the helm of the Condors in 2021-22, including a 13-5-1 (.711) mark in the team's final 19 games to secure home-ice advantage and a top-four divisional finish in the Calder Cup Playoffs. Bakersfield went on to defeat the Abbotsford Canucks in the first round, notching the team's first-ever postseason series sweep. The Toronto, Ontario native began the 2021-22 season as an assistant coach. Under his tutelage the team had the third best home power play (23.8%), 11th best penalty kill (81.7%), and was one of just three teams to be in the top-10 in both goals for (3.31) and goals against (2.82).

Individually, three Condors from this season went on to play in the 2022 Stanley Cup Playoffs (Philip Broberg, Dylan Holloway, Brad Malone). Also, Seth Griffith set a team scoring record, became the team's first 30-goal scorer, and was named a second team AHL All-Star.

It is Chaulk's first head coaching appointment in the AHL. He previously served as head coach in the ECHL for four seasons with Brampton and was an assistant with Belleville (AHL), Kalamazoo (ECHL), and Fort Wayne (ECHL).

KEITH McCAMBRIDGE - ASSISTANT COACH

McCambridge, 49, brings a decade of American Hockey League coaching experience as both a head coach and assistant. He served as head coach of the Hartford Wolf Pack from 2017-19, and with the Winnipeg Jets top AHL team in St. John's and Manitoba from 2011-2016. His time in St. John's included a trip to the Calder Cup Finals in 2014 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2012. Most recently, the Thompson, Manitoba native was an associate coach for two seasons with the Vancouver Giants of the Western Hockey League.

As a player, McCambridge played 11 seasons as a d-man in the AHL, IHL, and ECHL. He finished his playing career with the Alaska Aces (ECHL) and made the move behind the bench as their head coach from 2007-2009 with a trip to the Kelly Cup Finals in 2009.

NATE DiCASMIRRO - ASSISTANT COACH

Nate DiCasmirro joins the organization from the American Hockey League's (AHL) Iowa Wild, where he served as an assistant coach for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons. He helped the Wild secure their second Calder Cup Playoffs berth in the 2022-23 season. DiCasmirro began his coaching career in 2018-19 as an assistant coach with the Des Moines Buccaneers of the United States Hockey League (USHL). His coaching resume extends internationally, serving as an assistant coach with Team Austria's under-20 team at the 2022-23 World Junior Championships. DiCasmirro played 17 seasons professionally, including 401 games in the AHL. His AHL career included three seasons in the Oilers organization in Hamilton, Toronto, and Edmonton. Following his AHL time, DiCasmirro headed overseas for 11 seasons, with stops in Italy, England, Slovenia, Sweden, and Austria.

SYLVAIN RODRIGUE - GOALTENDING COACH

Sylvain Rodrigue began working on a full-time basis with Condors goaltenders in 2018-19, but has been with the Oilers organization for the past 11 seasons.

In 2020-21 under his guidance, Stuart Skinner made his NHL debut with the Edmonton Oilers and led the AHL in victories with 20 and in 2022-23 was a runner up for the Calder Trophy in the NHL.

He helped develop rookie goaltender Shane Starrett, who was named AHL Goaltender of the Month in February and received All-Rookie and Second All-Star Team selections from the AHL in 2018-19.

Rodrigue served as a Goaltending Consultant for the DEL's Berlin Eisbären, a member of Germany's top elite league and Fribourg Gotteron of the Swiss Elite League prior to joining the Oilers. He won the DEL championship with Berlin in 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13. He was also a member of Berlin's European trophy championship team in 2010-11.

The Montreal, Quebec native has also worked with HC Lugano (LNA – Swiss Elite League), AIK (Swedish Elite League) and Dusseldorf (DEL – German Elite
